Nashville, TN - Lexi Larsen, country music's rising newcomer and one of the Country Music Association's *CMA Closeup* magazine's "Who New To Watch in 2014" picks, will release her debut album *Good Memories* on Tuesday, April 8. The album release comes on the heels of some great reviews rolling in on her and her lead single "You Can Leave," written by Larsen, Karin Paparelli and Felicia Fay King. Lexi has made strong impressions with radio programmers while she was on her "Go Pink Radio Tour."
